Ohio Contractor Tom Martin Named SMACNA 2018 Contractor of the Year

As a trustee on his local Joint Apprenticeship and Training Committee, he is a champion of the union sheet metal industry training program, and is actively involved in a program that enables high school students to discover the benefits of a career in the sheet metal industry. Martin also collaborated with his labor partners to defeat a bill aimed at severely curtailing energy efficiency standards.

In addition to these many efforts, he has hosted numerous fundraisers for Ohio's governor, as well as other federal and state elected officials.

T.H. Martin, Inc. is a family-owned business started in 1985 by Martin's father, Thomas H. Martin. In his role as president, Martin works alongside his brother Mike Martin, who serves as vice president of the company. Tom resides in Bay Village, Ohio with his wife Kirstin and two children, Jake and Julia.
